From our synod, Pastor Laura Barbins (Celebration, Chardon), Pastor Woody Chamberlain (First, Lorain), and Pastor David Anderson (St. Matthew, Medina) were invited to make the nine-day trip to Israel and Palestine. The Jewish Community Federation sponsored the trip, which included representatives from other Christian denominations.

One of the intended outcomes of the trip was to foster greater understanding through sharing and interpreting their experiences with congregations after the trip. **Pastor Laura Barbins will be coming to speak to the Ashtabula County Lutheran Churches on Sunday, May 7 at 3:00 p.m. at Faith Lutheran Church located at 504 Lake Avenue in Ashtabula's harbor district (the corner of Lake Avenue and Bridge Street). A fellowship time with coffee and cookies will follow Pastor Barbins' presentation.**
