NRS Acts 9:10-11 Now there was a disciple in Damascus named Ananias. The Lord said to him in a vision, "Ananias". He answered, "Here I am, Lord." The Lord said to him, "Get up and go to the street called Straight..."

SPOTLIGHT ON “VISION” ***FOCUS ON YOUTH***



When the congregation met for the “Visioning” meeting last October, members suggested many specific and attainable goals for various areas of congregational life and ministry. This month’s *Spotlight on “Vision”* focuses on our youth.

At that meeting we ran out of time before addressing our youth ministry. Two aims were suggested after the meeting.

- Include the young Disciples of Christ in outreach to the community.
- Train and empower the youth at GSLC to be ambassadors of Jesus, sharing their faith with other young people.

Wonderful ideas, right? But how can we make those happen? Here are a few suggestions.

- Each of us as a member of this body of Christ must do our part to model Christian living for our youth. If our children see us sharing our faith, they may, too.
- Invite our youth to participate in the inner workings of the congregation, like helping behind the scenes at events or serving on committees.
- Invite and encourage your children or grandchildren to accompany you as you volunteer in the community.
- Personally invite members of families to minister together.
