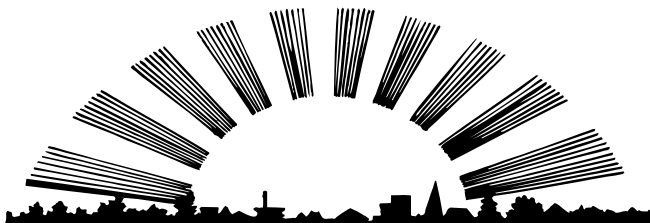

## Pastor's Corner June 2008

Normally after Memorial Day the church slows down. **Not this summer!!!!**

*"Suppose one of you had a servant plowing or looking after the sheep. Would he say to the servant when he comes in from the field, 'Come along now and sit down to eat'? <sup>8</sup> Would he not rather say, 'Prepare my supper, get yourself ready and wait on me while I eat and drink; after that you may eat and drink'? <sup>9</sup> Would he thank the servant because he did what he was told to do? <sup>10</sup> So you also, when you have done everything you were told to do, should say, 'We are unworthy servants; we have only done our duty.'"*

The world in which we live gives us many choices. Our commitment to Christ becomes clouded as we think about our needs over the needs of the church or the community. This summer, our faith community has made a commitment to serve the community through TeenServe, renovate the sanctuary, display Christ in the community with the 4<sup>th</sup> of July floats (3), extend Christ to the children through VBS, engage fellowship with the church picnic, raise money and awareness for the family center with a motorcycle and car show, and host a dedication service on August 31 for the newly renovated sanctuary. And with all that, we have only done our duty. Remember we are servants of Jesus... His disciples... Called and Sent.

When we place all this on paper and read it, we can truly see that we are a church serving Christ in the community. It doesn't matter if you have one day or six days of time to give, please give in the name of Jesus. I encourage you to give one or two days during the prep-week of TeenServe. Place Christ first and let your hands be the hands of God alive in the community.

The revitalization project is ready and we look to renew a sanctuary that glorifies God while preparing the worship space for the next generation of Christians. We pass on to the next generation a strong tradition of caring for the worship space, a commitment of faith, a love for the Gospel, and the knowledge of Jesus Christ as our Savior. *If you haven't made a donation to the Abiding Memorial in honor of, in memory of, or to the glory of God, there is still time to do so. The donations need to be into the church office by mid-July if they are to be part of the dedication. At the dedication service all the donations for the sanctuary will be listed and names read.*

The 4<sup>th</sup> of July parade will be exciting because we'll have three different floats. One float will display our VBS theme. Another designed by members... I have no idea what it will be. The last float will be the people of GSLC riding on a hay wagon. See the sign-up sheets to reserve your seat on the hay-wagon.

The only way that all these activities can happen is you!!  
YOU... being filled with the Love of Jesus, make a difference in the life of the church.  
YOU... who Love Jesus... Serve him and place him above worldly goods.

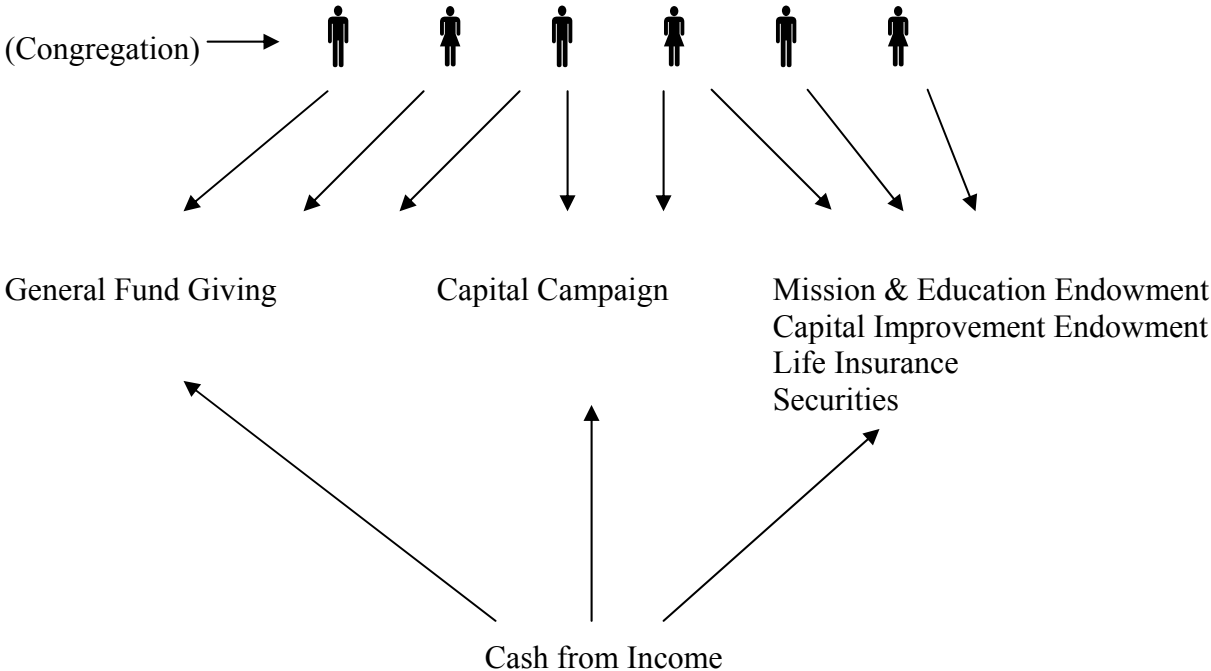
