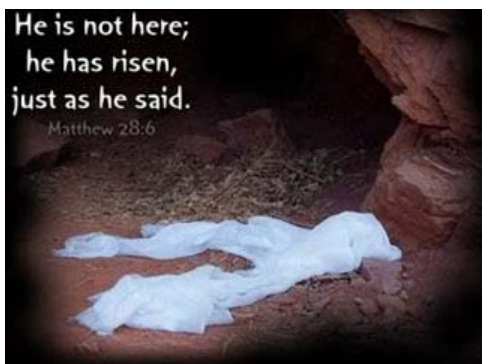

## Pastor's Corner May 2010



*"Then little children were being brought to him in order that he might lay his hands on them and pray. The disciples spoke sternly to those who brought them; <sup>14</sup> but Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me, and do not stop them; for it is to such as these that the kingdom of heaven belongs." <sup>15</sup> And he laid his hands on them and went on his way." Matthew 19*

The school year is coming to an end and so is the Christian Education year. Sunday mornings are active and loud in the education wing. I'm not sure if you've ventured down here on a Sunday morning but if you have, then you've heard the children laughing and doing work in class. Each Sunday I try and stop into the classrooms and say hello to the children and the teachers. We are fortunate to have devoted teachers. Their commitment to the children and the church makes Sunday mornings happen.

Last week as I did the children's message in the sanctuary at 11:00 AM service, about 40 children came forward and lined the center aisle as I did the message. The enjoyment of children in the church comes through invitation and commitment. Jesus tells his disciples and followers to let the children come to him. Therefore, we continue to invite our children, young adults and, yes, even the young at heart to come learn, listen, and be with Jesus. I want to thank you for accepting the children in the sanctuary and loving them as they learn and embrace their faith in worship. I love to hear their voices and I love to hear their "Amen" or even the "Yeah" after I get done with my sermon.

Another blessing that is coming together and alive at Good Shepherd is the new nursery. *"The Ruth Manniko Nursery"* is now being used on Sunday mornings for worship. At one point, I was informed that some of the children didn't want to leave the nursery to go home. I'm glad to hear that the children are enjoying this new place in Good Shepherd. I believe the children and the volunteer staff will love this new space. If you haven't stopped by the nursery to see what it looks like; stop in and check it out. The old office windows have a mirror coating so that parents can see in and children can't see out. The old space is refinished with insulation and drywall instead of block. The toy cabinets are full of pre-school toys and educational materials. There are 20 pagers available for parents so they can be in communication with the volunteer staff. What a difference this makes for the church. This wonderful place is the dream of one of the saints from Good Shepherd, Ruth Manniko Cain.

*Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me, and do not stop them; for it is to such as these that the kingdom of heaven belongs."* As Good Shepherd continues to grow in membership, we will continue to lift up the words of our Lord. I am thankful for the support and the love we share for the children in our community. By the way... I now have a magnet on my door to display this week's worship artwork. You can walk by anytime to see the drawings and the colorings the children did for me on Sunday.
