## OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD

Dear Members and Friends of Good Shepherd,

Everyone loves to receive gifts. During the Christmas season, we celebrate the arrival 2,000 years ago of the most special gift of all, God's Son, Jesus Christ. That "good news of great joy" (Luke 2:10) is the same message we seek to share with children around the world through Operation Christmas Child.

I would like to invite you to join this year's Operation Christmas Child project. We at Good Shepherd will be collecting gift-filled shoe boxes during the month of October. An Operation Christmas Child brochure is attached to the bottom of this letter. This gives all the instructions for filling a shoe box with gifts. Do you need a shoe box? There will be some empty boxes just waiting to be filled in the gathering space.

This year Operation Christmas Child will be witnessing God's love in Haiti. They will be distributing a record number of shoe box gifts to hurting children in Haiti to offer encouragement and support to young survivors of the January earthquake.

If possible, please include a check for \$7.00 to cover the cost of shipping. Checks should be made payable to Operation Christmas Child. While Samaritan's Purse would like a check included in every shoe box gift they will accept gifts without a check. The most important part of this program is the gifts and Christian books that will transform the lives of His precious children.

Remember to pray for the children who will be receiving your gifts. Did you know that in some parts of the world many children have never received a gift or heard about Jesus Christ? Together we can send love in the name of Jesus and then rejoice as we watch God use these simple gifts to transform the lives of His precious little ones.

Shoe Box Dedication Sunday will be during worship services on Sunday, November 14th. This will be the last day for accepting shoe box gifts. Our goal this year at Good Shepherd is to collect 100 boxes. Will you help us reach this goal?

The most important part of “The Church” that we must remember is that it's God's House! Taking care of God's House everyday requires a long list of tasks and no one task is more important than another. No matter how small the task, everything is vital to the ministry of the church and a strategic part of our worship to God. Just remember that whatever role you choose to take in the Church, know that it's important to God. He appreciates your service and the attitude you have as you do it!

A Church is made up of many types of people from a wide variety of backgrounds and they bring a multitude of gifts and abilities with them. Sometimes though, with a lot of varieties, our differences can divide people, but remember all believers, though different, have one thing in common, Faith in Christ! We should use our different gifts together to spread the Good News. When we do that, the end result can only be a united Church. By being baptized by one Holy Spirit, we become one body of believers in what we call **“The Church”!**
