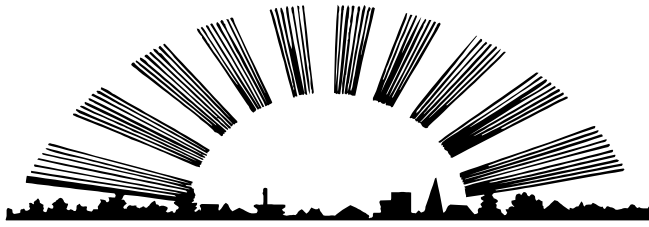

## Pastor's Corner May 2011

*“And suddenly there was a great earthquake; for an angel of the Lord, descending from heaven, came and rolled back the stone and sat on it. <sup>3</sup> His appearance was like lightning, and his clothing white as snow. <sup>4</sup> For fear of him the guards shook and became like dead men. <sup>5</sup> But the angel said to the women, “Do not be afraid; I know that you are looking for Jesus who was crucified. <sup>6</sup> He is not here; for he has been raised, as he said. Come, see the place where he<sup>1</sup> lay.” (Matthew 28:2-6)*

Christ is Risen... He is Risen indeed, Alleluia!

On Resurrection Sunday, I spoke to you about the empty tomb and God's action for us. We learn from personal experience that sometimes the lessons and the path we take are opposite of God's plan for us. In that, we create our own tomb and are closed off to the world through our actions, behavior, and hypocrisy. Yet, God does not give up on you and I. God's love for you and I go beyond our comprehension.

As we begin our seventh year together, I can pray and hope that the words of the angels ring in your ears for years to come. *“Do not be afraid”* the angels told the evangelists in Matthew's Gospel. Why would I make such a statement? You're probably wondering why you should be afraid. Let me give you some reasons that might come up as you continue to grow in faith and love for God and each other.

*“Do not be afraid”* when coming to church each week is important to you.

*“Do not be afraid”* when you feel strangely moved to want to do more for God and for his people.

*“Do not be afraid”* when you sense God's calling you into a ministry that is unfamiliar.

*“Do not be afraid”* when your family or friends sense a change in you and you say, “It's God”.

*“Do not be afraid”* when your tomb is opened and the light of Christ is shining around you.

I pray that with God's help, you are able to break down the fears that hold you back. I pray with God's help, you will be able to sustain a life with Him and know that Jesus is Lord in your life.

*“For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith – and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God – not by works, so that no one can Boast.” (Eph. 2:8-9)*
